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Warpaint—Ready and Lethal

Warpaint continues to thrive in its new environment! The month of May offered us a variety of excellent opportunities to prove our prowess in Warfighting, Lethality, and Readiness through training exercises such as Combined Resolve, the Immediate Response Package (IRP), and Operation Hedgehog. We have a great momentum behind us as we move into the Summer months.

Combined Resolve was an excellent culminating event for the Squadron. This large-scale combat exercise paired the Squadron with NATO and other partner nation soldiers while testing our ability to fight in a new environment. It was exciting to implement a new augmented reality system to increase maintenance efficiencies and quickly identify vehicle issues and the proper solution. Our S6 team shined, utilizing new technologies to maintain the Squadron's connectivity to the network in a dynamic environment.

In a display of Readiness, The Immediate Response Package gives a mechanized unit the ability to deploy anywhere in the world within 96 hours. This exercise allowed us to rapidly deploy packages from Tartu and Amari Estonia into Germany as part of Combined Resolve. It was the first time an aircraft as large as the C-17 Globemaster had ever taken off from the public airfield in Tartu.

As part of Operation Hedgehog, Apache Troop had the opportunity to work alongside the Estonian Defense League and other allied Troops from 11 NATO nations. Apache did a great job showcasing their ability to adapt to an urban battlefield—conducting offensive operations on Estonian roads and cities. They went on to continue training alongside the Estonians in a joint live fire exercise consisting of Bradley's from Apache and Estonian dismounts.

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Moving into June, our focus will be on conducting vehicle services to maintain the lethality and readiness of our combat systems. This deployment has certainly provided the Squadron with a lot of excellent training opportunities; our Warfighters are constantly achieving new levels of success and accomplishment. 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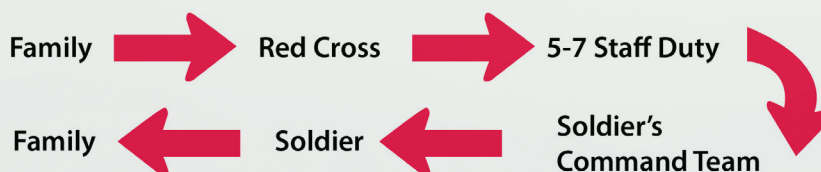
